

PINOT NOIR 2016 SINGLE VINEYARD



The clones planted in this vineyard block grow in high mineral content soil. The site is refreshed by ocean breezes that allow the fruit to fully develop and give a distinct character.

Of carmine red, this Pinot Noir is bright, elegant and expressive with aromas of cherries and roses. In the palate, flavours of red fruits and a touch of earthiness unfold. Complex with notes of mocha from barrel aging in the finish.
