In the mouth, it is juicy with an unctuous quality, making it an elegant wine with an intense finish.

Located eleven miles from the Atlantic Ocean, our estate has more than 1,000 small vineyard blocks covering its hillside slopes, which benefit from varying microclimates, different levels of humidity, and an intense canopy management. The vineyards are surrounded by lush forests, rocky soils, granite boulders, and naturally occurring palm trees.
